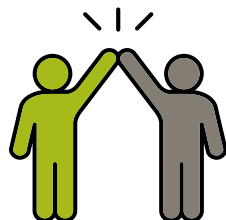

The Annual Community Paint-a-thon is designed to help persons 60 and better, veterans and the disabled, to continue to live independently by externally restoring their homes.



Community members come together to prepare the exterior for painting including scraping, sanding, caulking, priming, and landscaping before painting. Many teams additionally provide exterior planting, cleaning or replacing yard furniture, painting, and repairs of flower boxes, doors, fences, decks, light fixtures, and more.
